



GUIDE TO SELECTING A PROJECTION SCREEN

Determine the optimum screen size based on the room dimensions and the planned audience seating size and arrangement. The rule of thumb is to fit the screen to the audience – not to the projector.

- Screen height should be approximately equal to 1/6 the distance from the screen to the last row of seats.
- Ideally, the first row of seats should be approximately 2 screen heights away.
- The bottom of the screen should be as much as 4 feet above the audience floor, allowing those seated toward the rear of the audience to see the screen.

Select the format for your projection. Most popular business projection formats fit comfortably on our standard tripod and Fast Fold screens. If you are giving a widescreen presentation or showing an HDTV presentation please use one of our Home Theater screens
